

Coronavirus (Covid 19) Catch Up Premium



Total Allocation: £21,600

Children and young people across the country have experience unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of the Covid 19 outbreak. Those from the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds have been hardest hit. Schools allocation is calculated on a per pupil basis providing each mainstream school with a total of £80 per pupil.

Schools must use their funding for specific activities to support pupils to catch up for lost teaching over the previous months due to Covid 19. Schools have the flexibility to spend their funding in the best way for their cohorts.

To support schools the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) has produced guidance with evidence based approaches to catch up for all students.

The EEF advises the following:

- Supporting quality first teaching
- Supporting 1:1 and small group tuition
- Supporting intervention programme
