



Parent Questionnaire Summary Summer Term 2021

124 parent questionnaires were returned to us; 13 in nursery, 35 in reception, 25 in year 1 and 51 in year 2.

In general parents/carers were pleased with the progress that their children have made during the academic year considering the exceptional circumstances. The provision for online learning was acknowledged and appreciated, with praise given to staff for the effort and support they provided and how well they adapted to delivering lessons online.

There has, however, been a number of comments regarding the lack of pupil's progress updates and parents' evenings during the year, with some parents/carers stating that they have received little or no updates (across all year groups), and some suggesting that a virtual parents' evening/phone call would have been beneficial.

A handful of comments made regarding issues on the playground/lack of supervision during playtimes.

Key points from the results are:

1. 100% of parents/carers either strongly agree or agree that their child is happy at school
2. 99% either strongly agree or agree that their child feels safe at the school
3. 88% either strongly agree or agree that their child has made good progress this year despite the pandemic
4. 94% either strongly agree or agree that the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved
5. 78% either strongly agree or agree that their child receives an appropriate amount of homework
6. 74% either strongly agree or agree that they find Westacre Warm Ups useful
7. 60% either strongly agree or agree that they receive valuable information about their child's progress
8. 90% either strongly agree or agree that the school responds well to any concerns that they raise
9. 98% either strongly agree or agree that they would recommend this school to other parents
10. 91% either strongly agree or agree that if their child has additional needs they feel that they are supported (58 replied to this question)
