These are the areas of learning your child will be covering over the next **two** weeks. You might be able to support your child with these through practical activities, by talking to them about what they are learning and helping to develop their understanding.

Weeks beginning 19th and 26th February 2024

Maths

In Maths, will be completing our unit on Addition and Subtraction (within 20):

- Subtraction – finding the difference
- Related facts
- Missing number problems

We will then move onto Place Value (within 50):

- Counting from 20 to 50
- 20, 30, 40 and 50
- Count by making groups of 10

Education City support activities:

- Heist to see you (Number bonds up to 20)
- One, Two, Bee (Adding and subtracting to 20)
- Prince Charming (Missing number + and – problems)
- ‘Counting in Stens’ - Counting in 10s to 100

English

In English we will be starting our journey story based on: “There’s a Rang-Tan in my Bedroom” by James Sellick. We will start by understanding the ideas, details and vocabulary within the story and then remembering and rehearsing the story, using a story map with actions. We will share our ideas by speaking fluently and clearly to others. We will then move onto:

- Identifying and using vocabulary within the text
- Using capital letters for names in our writing
- Using the prefix un-
- Understanding what ‘conjunctions’ are and using the conjunctions: and, so and but in sentences we say and then write. Learning that conjunctions join 2 simple sentences together to make them more interesting and giving more information
- Reading and Spelling Year 1 Common Exception Words: he, me, she, we, no, go, so

- Handwriting Practise – focus on curly caterpillar letters g, q, o and s.
- Roots to Riches – Pre-fix un
