These are the areas of learning your child will be covering over the next **two** weeks. You might be able to support your child with these through practical activities, by talking to them about what they are learning and helping to develop their understanding.

Weeks beginning 23rd and 30th September 2024

Maths

We will be continuing our unit of work on Place Value. We will be following small steps of learning from White Rose Maths:

- 10s and 1s on the number line to 100
- Estimate numbers on a number line
- Compare objects
- Compare numbers
- Order objects and numbers
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Count in 3s

Education City support activities:

- Hang Tenth's – Place Value with 2-digit numbers
- Party Like It's 19 or 99 – number representations - identify and estimate numbers to 100
- Organic Ordering – ordering numbers 1 to 99
- Ridiculous Roads – count on or back in 10s from any 2-digit number

Reminder: Don't forget the White Rose Maths app called "1-Minute Maths". This app helps children build greater number confidence and fluency. It's all about targeted practice in engaging, one-minute chunks! You can also download a wall chart to keep a track of your child's scores at home. Try to get your child to complete activities on the White Rose 1-Minute Maths app for 5 minutes each day.

Spelling

Each week our children will focus on learning a new spelling rule. Please help your child to practise the words that they will be learning to spell. We assess spelling through written tasks during lessons, we do not administer a spelling test.

Week commencing 23rd September: We are learning to add the suffix -y to words where we have to double the consonant. Eg. bog boggy

Focus words: boggy, dotty, foggy, funny, muddy, nutty, runny, saggy, sloppy, spotty, sunny, yummy.

Week commencing 30th September: We will be learning to add the suffix -y to words we have to drop the e. Eg. shine shiny

Focus words: bony, breezy, cheesy, crazy, curvy, greasy, lazy, mousy, shiny, simply, smoky, snappy, spicy, spiky, sunny, wavy, wheezy, whiny.
