This half term we will be finding out about 'I Wonder'

PSHE

We will be learning the Nursery Rules.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know that we need to use kind hands, words and feet in Nursery.

We will learn about different feelings.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know the names to describe feeling happy and sad.

We will be learning about different body parts.

Key Knowledge and Skills: We will know the names of different body parts; Head, eyes, ears, nose, arms, hands, legs and feet.



Literacy

We will begin to develop our phonological awareness through a variety of different ways.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know the logos for local supermarkets.

We will spot and suggest rhymes.

We will read and reread a selection of books.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

Know how to retell the story of Owl Babies



Expressive Arts and Design

We will learn different nursery rhymes and songs

Key knowledge and Skills:

Know the words and rhythm to at least five Nursery rhymes off by heart such as; Humpty Dumpty, Twinkle Twinkle Little Star/ Twinkle Twinkle Chocolate Bar and Incy Wincy Spider.

We will explore different materials freely in order to develop our ideas about how to use them and what to make.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will know some materials that they can use to join/stick things together e.g. glue, cello tape.



Understanding the World

We will be understanding and celebrating different festivals .

Key Knowledge and Skills: We will know why and how we celebrate; Harvest Diwali, Fireworks Night and Christmas.

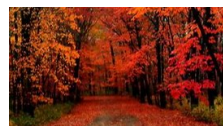
We will begin to make sense of our own life-story and our family's history.

We will learn to sort by colour ,objects and size.

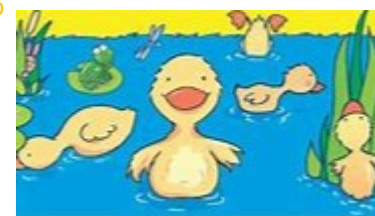
Key Knowledge and Skills: We will be recognising and being able to name different colours such as; Red, blue, yellow, orange, green and purple.
